PEEL OFF BACKERS

OPEN THE BOX

You will find the moulded Frameguard with 4 self adhesive fastening tabs already mounted. Do not take off the backer from the tabs just yet.



Inside the polymer
Frameguard is a metal
reinforcing insert. This helps you
bend the Frameguard to fit the
shape of your frame. Do this
with your tabs still in place.



Bring the Frameguard to the frame and press lightly so that the tabs make a light tack to the frame. Undo the Velcro straps and pull the Frameguard away, leaving the tabs fastened to the frame.

Press the tabs firmly all over so that they bend to the shape of your frame (some eBike frames will be almost flat and some conventional alloy tubes will be quite curved), so that the adhesive makes a proper bond.



Thread the Velcro straps through the guide holes and secure the strap. To remove the Frameguard, simply undo the straps and pull it off, leaving the tabs fastened to the frame*.

Frameguard has been specially designed to fit a wide range of bikes currently available on the market.

Additional Velcro Strap Supplied

We've included a spare length of Velcro to assist

in fitting in-case you are unable to attach one of the tabs. Simply remove the tab and thread the Velcro through the holes and around your frame.

*Frameguard will not move under wet, muddy or harsh riding/cleaning conditions - however, the tabs will peel away under hairdryer heat, leaving no damage to paint work.
